

#### THE IDEAL MAN

#### A Jot From John,

"I can soon learn how to do it if you'll let me see it done." These are words from a poem by Edgar A. Guest. God gave Jesus Christ as a Model for all people to follow. (1 Peter 2:12-25). He is Saviour of all men first; next He is a Model Man, a Model Husband, and a Model Father. Does this sound strange?

As an Ideal Man He had courage and strength enough to expose the corrupt practices in the temple. Imagine if you can, His taking a whip in hand and driving out both the sheep and the oxen. (John 2:15-16).

What a sight! Can you not plainly see the confusion, hear the bellowing of the cattle, and the bleating of the sheep as they rushed pell-mell out of the temple? Jesus is no weakling! He had physical strength and the courage of His convictions – He lived by them!

Still, the Ideal Man had a warmth of feeling and sympathy toward others. (Matt.14; Luke 7; John 11.) Jesus loved people. Some have confused humility with timidity. Jesus was humble but in no sense could be be called timid! People can imitate Jesus; He is a Model Man.

Jesus is a Model Husband. NO! He was never married to a woman, but all redeemed people are married to Him. (Romans 7:4.) Marriage is such a sacred relationship; the Holy Spirit uses it to illustrate the relationship which exists between Christ and the church. (Eph. 5:22-23.)

Jesus is a Model Father. God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself (2 Cor. 5:19) so this makes Him an Ideal Father. The father's role is to train, protect, and provide for the needs of His family; he sets and example for His children to follow. The father gives time to his children – he gives some of himself; he works with them and teaches them the dignity of labor; he plays with them and helps them to learn how to win gracefully and to lose with good spirit and honor.

A father speaks a language which all people understand; he paints a picture which all can see and appreciate; he creates foot-steps in which little ones can walk; he motivates ambition in little hearts who admire him; he teaches lessons by his examples.

God is interested in all people; He gives us Jesus as Saviour and an Ideal to follow! He is a Model Man, a Model Husband, and a Model Father!


